

1 1/8 MILES. (1.42) 42ND RUNNING OF THE RISEN STAR. GRADE II. Purse \$400,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$400 by Saturday, February 8 (Louisiana Derby early bird nominees automatically subscribed); \$2,000 to enter, \$2,000 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$8,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$400,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a grade I or II stakes allowed 2 lbs, a sweepstakes at a mile or over, allowed 4 lbs, \$27,000 twice at a mile or over allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Risen Star Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to horses that have accumulated the highest lifetime earning at the time of passing entry box. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, February 8, 2014, with 93 nominations.

INTENSE HOLIDAY was fractious in the paddock, came away in good order, was taken in hand while off heels midway through the first turn, raced in the two path on that bend, was reserved near the middle of the field, went three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide at the five-sixteenths, advanced into the stretch, came under a left-handed whip, rallied on the outside and closed well to get up late under continued left-hand urging. ALBANO set the pace on the inside, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire. VICAR'S IN TROUBLE went four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside while near the middle of the field, advanced four wide on the far turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, chased the leader under a drive, switched to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and weakened while able to get the show. HOPPERTUNITY went two then three wide early on the first turn, moved to four wide late on that bend, was reserved off the pace, came under urging near the half-mile pole, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn, shifted six wide into the stretch, drifted in while under a drive at the furlong marker and improved position. GOLD HAWK was reluctant to load, went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and tired. COMMANDING CURVE moved in early, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, went two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide late on that bend, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. RISE UP broke a step slow, was rank early, moved up while under restraint late on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, chased in the two path on the far turn and capitulated. FLAT GONE was reserved on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, came off the rail late on the far turn and failed to threaten. SON OF A PREACHER went four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, settled nicely off the pace, was urged along near the half-mile pole, raced in the two path on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the whip and came up empty. QUICK INDIAN raced in the two path on the first turn, lingered near the back, was urged along at the half-mile pole, went two then three wide on the far turn and was no factor. VIGORISH went two then three wide on the first turn, was well placed in third position, chased inside on the far turn and came up empty. EMMETT PARK lagged well behind, raced inside on the turns and showed little. INTERCHANGE stumbled at the start, fought the rider while taken back early, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved near the rear, raced three wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide near the five-sixteenths pole and never reached contention. XTRA LUCK went four then five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four to five wide on the far turn and failed to respond.
